Introduction

eLeasing Limited (trading as eLeasing) is committed to protecting your privacy and handling your personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 2020 (New Zealand).

This Privacy Policy explains what personal information we may collect, how we collect it, why we collect it, how we may use and disclose it, and how we protect it.

Information We Collect

We may collect personal and business information including:

- Your name, company or organisation name and job title.
- Contact details such as phone number, email address and postal address.
- Information relating to equipment purchases, finance enquiries and leasing requirements.
- Financial information provided to support finance applications.
- Identity and verification information required to meet Anti-Money Laundering and Countering Financing of Terrorism (AML/CFT) obligations.
- Information submitted through our website, online forms, calculators or by email.
- Technical information such as IP address, browser type and website usage analytics.

Information Collected from Other Sources

We may also obtain personal information about you from third parties where permitted by law. These may include finance companies, lenders and funding partners, credit reporting agencies, equipment suppliers, professional advisers and other persons or organisations involved in a finance application, enquiry or transaction.

Where required by the Privacy Act 2020, we will take reasonable steps to ensure you are informed about the collection of personal information obtained from another source.

How We Use Your Information

We may use your information to:

- Respond to enquiries.
- Arrange and administer equipment finance and leasing facilities.
- Assess and facilitate finance applications.
- Verify your identity and undertake credit, fraud prevention and other checks where appropriate.
- Meet legal, regulatory and AML/CFT obligations.
- Communicate with customers, suppliers, finance partners and other parties involved in a transaction.
- Improve our website, products and services.
- Send relevant updates or marketing communications where permitted by law.
- Protect our legitimate business interests and comply with our legal obligations.

Disclosure of Information

We may disclose your information where reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including:

- Finance companies, lenders and funding partners for the assessment, approval and administration of finance.
- Credit reporting agencies where authorised or permitted by law.
- Identity verification, AML/CFT and fraud prevention service providers.
- Equipment suppliers and other parties involved in arranging or completing a transaction, where appropriate.
- Professional advisers, technology providers and trusted service providers assisting us in operating our business.
- Government authorities, regulators, law enforcement agencies or other parties where required or permitted by law.

We do not sell your personal information.

Overseas Disclosure and Service Providers

Some of our technology providers, service providers or other recipients may store or process information outside New Zealand.

Where personal information is disclosed outside New Zealand, we will take reasonable steps to ensure that the disclosure is made in accordance with the Privacy Act 2020 and that appropriate safeguards apply where required.

Storage and Security

We take reasonable technical and organisational measures to protect personal information from loss, unauthorised access, misuse, disclosure, alteration or other unauthorised use.

Personal information is stored using systems and service providers that we consider appropriate for the nature of the information involved, and access is restricted to authorised persons and service providers who require access for legitimate purposes.

However, no method of electronic transmission or storage can be guaranteed to be completely secure.

Cookies and Website Analytics

Our website may use cookies and analytics tools to understand how visitors use the website, improve functionality and enhance the user experience.

Cookies may collect technical information about your device, browser and use of our website.

You can manage or disable cookies through your browser settings, although doing so may affect some website functionality.

Access and Correction

You may request access to the personal information we hold about you and request correction of any information you believe is inaccurate or incomplete, subject to the Privacy Act 2020.

To request access to or correction of your personal information, please contact us using the details below.

Retention of Information

We retain personal information only for as long as reasonably necessary to provide our services, administer finance arrangements, meet legal and regulatory obligations, resolve disputes, maintain appropriate business records and enforce our agreements.

When personal information is no longer required, we will take reasonable steps to securely delete, destroy or otherwise dispose of it where appropriate.

Privacy Breaches

If a privacy breach occurs, we will assess and respond to the breach in accordance with our obligations under the Privacy Act 2020, including notifying the Office of the Privacy Commissioner and affected individuals where required by law.

Third-Party Websites

Our website may contain links to third-party websites. We are not responsible for the privacy practices, security or content of those websites. You should review the privacy policies of third-party websites before providing personal information to them.

Changes to this Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes to our business, website, services or legal obligations.
